

If parents/caregivers are involved in this review, send them the following instructions:

- 1. Enter the username (waihieast) and password (eastpolicy).
- 2. Follow the link to the relevant policy as listed.
- 3. Read the policy.
- 4. Click the Policy Review button at the top right-hand corner of the page.
- 5. Select the reviewer type "Parent".
- 6. Enter your name (optional).
- 7. Submit your ratings and comments.
- 8. If you don't have internet access, school office staff can provide you with printed copies of the policy and a review form.

BREAKFAST IDEAS

EASY OMELETTE

- · 2 eggs
- · 2 Tbsp water or milk
- · Pinch of salt and pepper
- 1/2 c filling edam cheese and/or your favourite vegetables e.g. tomato, capsicum

Whisk eggs, milk, salt & pepper and pour into a medium sized, non-stick pan. When the egg mixture

is nearly cooked add the filling to one half of the omelette and gently fold the other half on top.

Due to low numbers we will not be going to Hockey Big Day out. If you would like your child to participate and are able to take them, see Briar for more info.


COMMUNITY NOTICES
