### NOTICES AND REMINDERS

Kia Ora Whanau,

I trust this week has been fabulous for you!

We have lots of sickness niggles in our community, which understandably, makes people feel a bit nervous about whether to send their kiddies to school. It was timely that the Ministry of Education sent the below message to schools yesterday - I hope it helps.

The Ministry of Health has confirmed that the guidance for returning to schools following vomiting or diarrhoea has not changed. If a child is free of those symptoms for 48 hours, they can attend school again. We have updated the winter wellness guidance for parents, caregivers and whānau to reflect the following points:

- If a child has been unwell with a respiratory illness other than COVID-19, they can return to school 24 hours after they have significantly improved and are behaving/eating normally.
- Following vomiting or diarrhoea, a child should be symptom free for 48 hours before they can re turn.
- If they still have a runny nose or dry cough without any other symptoms such as a fever, vomiting or diarrhoea, then they are unlikely to be infectious and can be considered well enough to attend school.
- In general, a doctor's certificate or clearance should not have to be provided for a child to go back to school after being unwell.

This week, we were treated to the Discovery Centres song about peace, love, hope and joy - it was so uplifting and just delightful! It also reminded us all that every day we have is a gift, and our little people have sure led the way in showing us how to live it! Ka pai tamariki, you really do shine!

It's neat to see so many entries into our Ag Day coming up in November. Each child will have the opportunity to be a part of the day, some will have animals, and others will have the opportunity to create something fabulous at home to bring in. I also hear there will be our famous Ag Day cake auction! Can't wait already!

Enrolment at our school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Applications for out-of-zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during the period for Term 4 2022 (This includes students applying to be treated as in-zone students under transition provisions.)

The deadline for receipt of applications places is 28th August 2022.

If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on 29th August 2022. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

If you live in the home zone and have not yet signaled your intention to enroll your child later this year, please contact he school immediately to assist us to plan appropriately.

On Monday we all went to the Museum. A man showed us the river and boats too. We saw a shed for boats it was all old. Yack! Charlie B, Year 3


The Ohinemuri Trip





