Respect - Whakarangatiratanga, Responsibility - Tutika and Caring - Manaakitanga.

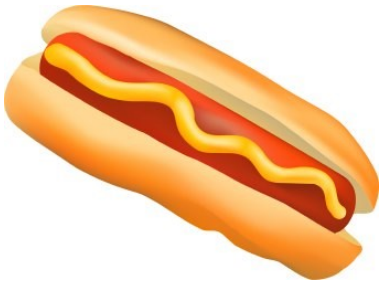

All orders to the office by Tuesday please to allow time to shop for supplies.

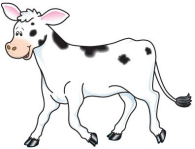
YEAR 5 & 6 BASKETBALL

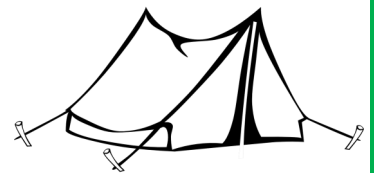
YUMMY STICKERS
