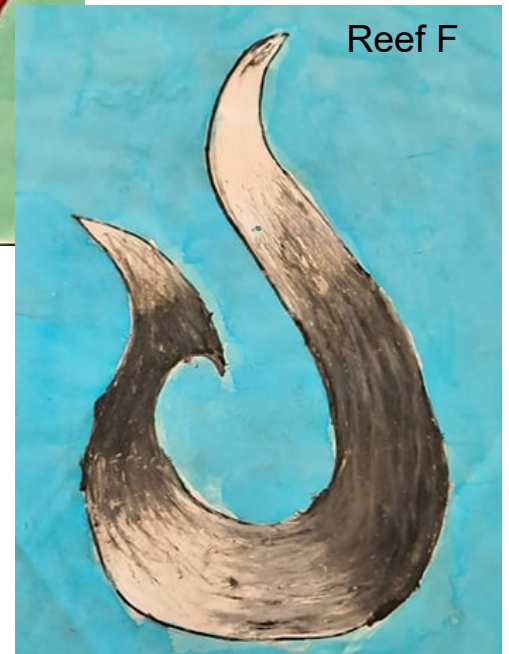


Sadly missing a few in the photo, but

Prizes are on their way to school now and will be here before the end of the term.



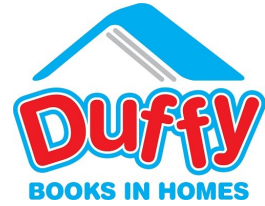
WEEKLY NOTICES AND REMINDERS
