You may have heard of the Kai Care Packs that Waihi College have been making recently. As you know, all our Waihi College students receive a free lunch as part of the Ka Ora, Ka Ako programme. The ingredients for these lunches come to us every day and a private company called Libelle, make them into nutritious lunches for our kids.

Last term, we started turning the left over ingredients into frozen meals which we package up and give out to the community once a week on a Wednesday. ATTENDANCE MATTERS

What if my child is sick?

Children will get sick and need to stay home occasionally. However, don't let your child stay home unless they are truly sick. Keep in mind complaints such as a stomach ache or headache can be a sign of anxiety and not a reason to stay home. Don't send your child to school if they have a fever, diarrhoea, vomiting, a serious cough, rash, conjunctivitis or a contagious illness e.g. chicken pox.



Always inform the school if your child is absent due to illness. If they are anxious about going to school talk to your child's teacher.

Did you know that if you don't contact the school when your child is absent they are marked as Truant?

Please return all boxes either sold or unsold now. Thanks.



Enrolment at our school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Applications for out-of-zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during the period for term 2 2022 (This includes students applying to be treated as in-zone students under transition provisions.)

The deadline for receipt of applications places is 5th June 2022.

If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on 6th June 2022. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

If you live in the home zone and have not yet signaled your intention to enroll your child later this year, please contact the school immediately to assist us to plan appropriately.
