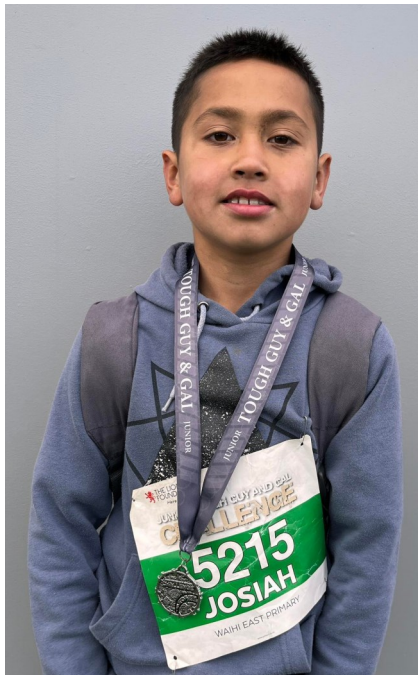

ENROLMENT SCHEME

Public Notice advertising details of pre-enrolment procedures and subsequent balloting Procedures.

Enrolment at our school is governed by an enrolment scheme, detail of which are available from the school office.

Applications for out-of-zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during the period for term 3 2022 (This includes students applying to be treated as in-zone students under transition provisions.)

The deadline for receipt of applications places is 24th July 2022.

If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on 25th July 2022. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

If you live in the home zone and have not yet signaled your intention to enroll your child later this year, please contact the school immediately to assist us to plan appropriately.

at Whiri'toa



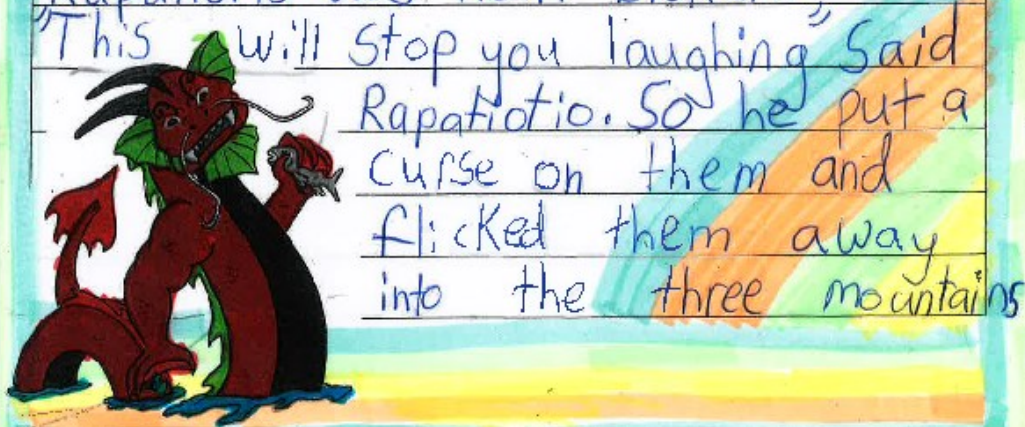
Swimming in the blowhole,
