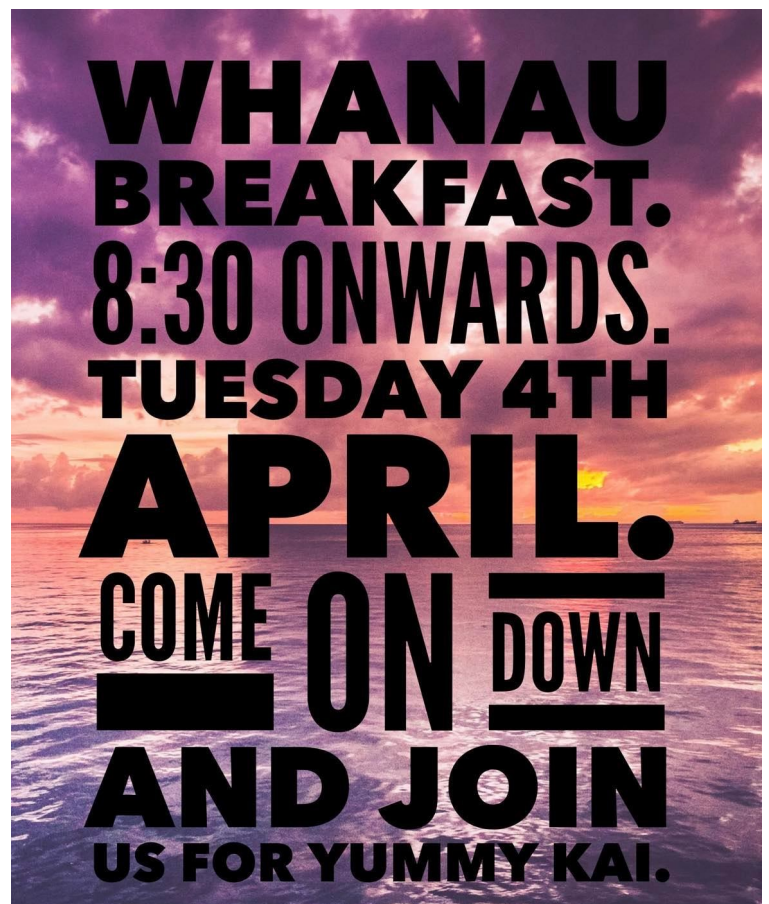


Caregiver App

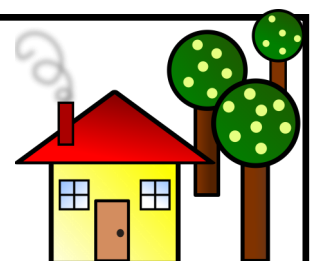
