FIREWOOD RAFFLE

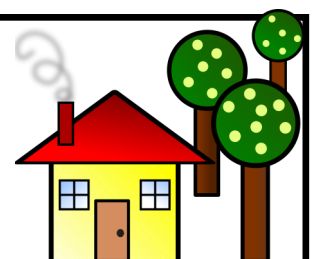
We have a trailer full of firewood to raffle. Tickets available at the office \$5 each.


