It has been a great week!

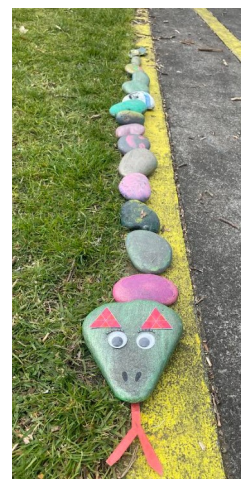

9. Agree to the privacy statement and click "Submit review".

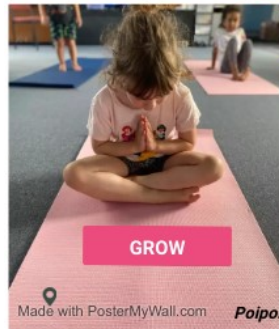
