


for donating time and resources for our school van to have a tow bar fitted - how brilliant are they!! We are very thrilled and thankful.

Juicies are for sale every day until stock runs out. \$2 each. Go to the office at morning tea or lunch time to buy one. Three flavours.


FIREWOOD RAFFLE


