We have had an amazing week of Swim School with Tess and Sue working with our classes each day. Our children have been keen, engaged and very brave trying new things. Our seniors move to the College pool next week for their sessions.

Congratulations to our tamariki who represented Waihi East at the Cluster Swimming Sports today, you made us proud.

This year we have Vanessa McHardy working with us to deliver a wellbeing package within our school, 'Life Skills for Mental Health and Wellbeing. A Whole School Community Approach.' Vanessa is an Integrative Child Psychotherapist trained in the UK with up to 20 years experience working with children and adolescents. The programme is designed to reduce anxiety through teaching life skills and understanding about the brain and self. Vanessa runs staff development, sessions in classrooms for tamariki as well as sessions for whānau. Our first whānau session is next Friday 15th March 2pm - 3pm here at school. Everyone is welcome to come along and meet Vanessa and find out some more about the programme.

Surf and Turf for our Year 3 and 4 tamariki is coming up quick! There is a Whānau Hui next Wednesday for those coming along to join us.


